Location:	All Brighter Access Supported Independent Living Houses
Who this applies to:	All staff working within a Brighter Access workplace
	Participants and visitors
Actions:	Visits must be inline with government recommendations
	Visits should be announced and COVID-19 screening questions undertaken prior to arrival
	 Upon arrival to the house, visitor's will be re-screened, temperature taken and staff will complete the COVID-19 visitors log. If the temperature is above 38 degrees, they will be asked to postpone their visit until their temperature is below 38 degrees
	4. Maintain social distance at all times
	 Once the visitor has left the house, the participant and staff must wash their hands. Staff will then remove any rubbish from the visit eg drink containers by placing in a plastic bag and discarding in the outside bin
	 Staff must then clean the area as per the cleaning schedule to ensure safe hygiene standards are maintained at all times
Please Note:	a. Visitors are to be mindful of government recommendationsb. Staff to be vigilant around cleaning and infection control
